- If you make a mistake, tear, or deface the ballot, return it to an election official and obtain another ballot. DO NOT ERASE.

PROPOSAL 2 To see if the voters will amend the Vermont Constitution by amending Article 1 of Chapter 1 to read: “Article 1.
